Fork Base (452837) (#10) is replaced with 2 BT01 3/8-16 x 2" Low Fork Base (452816) (#10) is replaced with 2-BT01 3/8-16x2" and uses CA13 Casters

### **CUP HOLDERS FOR THE 4928 ARE DISHWASHER SAFE**



- 1 Lay (#1) top on table or floor with (#2) Top Bracket as shown
- 2 Insert Top Mounting Bolts (#5) into the Back Plate (#4) and screw the bolts into the top Bracket (#2)
- 3 Insert the Column Assembly (#6) with the shipping screw (#13) facing inwards, as shown. The embossed dimples on the Back Mounting Plate (#4) and the Top Bracket (#2) must fit into the mating holes at the end of the outer column. Tighten the bolts with a 9/16" wrench.
- Carefully install the four Casters (#8) into the Base Assembly (#7) Δ
- Insert two bolts (#10) through the Bolt Plate (#9), and then through the Base Assembly (#7) as 5 shown. Align the bolts with the holes in the bottom of the inner column and tighten with 9/16" wrench.
- Place the complete table upright on the casters. 6
- Install two Hole Plugs (#12) into the base leg opposite the column. 7
- Remove the Shipping Screw (#13) and discard. 8

## **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1 To raise or lower the top, squeeze the Trip Lever (#2) upward to release the lock and adjust the top to the desired position.
- 2 To lubricate the Column Assembly (#6), raise the top until the Column Assembly (#6) is fully extended. Located the lubrication port (#15) and apply a small amount of spray lubricant or lighter machine oil, repeat as needed. Rev. A 4/20/15
